



Vocations

Did you know? The Vatican releases a global Catholic statistical report each year. Here are a few highlights: Worldwide the number of priests dropped by 2,347. Europe experienced the largest decline, while Africa and Asia experienced an increase. Africa had an increase of 1,518 priests and shines in vocations to the priesthood. It is the only continent registering an increase in the number of both major and minor seminarians. The global count of permanent deacons increased slightly, but men and women religious experienced a concerning decline, especially in Europe and Latin America. All the while, the Catholic population worldwide increased by 16.2 million from 2022. Source: vaticannews.va
